Our Reading and Writing Program follows the Model Curriculum Units of the Worcester Public Schools. The workshop model for grade 1 consists of:

\* Mini-lesson: The teacher demonstrates a
Reading/Writing skill or strategy to the students. \*
Independent Work Time: The children go off and
independently read or write practicing the skill or
strategy presented in the lesson. \* During this
time, the teacher will be conferring with individual
students or working on guided reading with small
groups. \*Share: The children are called back
together on the rug to share their successes or
questions they have with the skill or strategy.



Reading every night is so important. Although it is essential to encourage and support your child's effort to learn English, books in your native language are very beneficial and we encourage parents not to shy away from reading them with their children just because they're not in English. Research has shown that children who are read to in their home language have less difficulty learning a second language.

## READING TIPS

- 1. Take a picture walk through the book. Try to predict what the story is about. 2. Ask who, when, where and what questions about the story.
- Review vocabulary and sight words within the story.
- 4. Summarize the story. Discuss what they liked or disliked about the book.

## Homework is a great way to reinforce skills as well as keep you updated with what we are learning in class. Homework will be
